Any other matters

Account – the audit accounts were approved and signed by council.

Site by 1 Bro Alwen – a letter of concern receive saying that the parking of cars in the site opposite Neuadd Wen is causing an obstruction for people and children on bikes using the little path leading to this site, it was decided to place a No Parking sign, and monitor the situation.

Childrens play park behind council houses – it was noted the fencing is in poor state the Clarke to contact Conwy Council.
