Minutes of the last meeting held on 12th March 2024 at 7.30

Present were Eryl Evans (chairman), Gethin Jones, Arwyn Ellis, Helen Jones attended after our meeting with Bute Energy (because she declared an expression of interest.) Apologies from Llyr Jones, Medwyn Roberts, Generys Roberts and Cll Gwennol Ellis.

A meeting was held with three members working for Bute Energy on the Moel Chwa wind farm. It was stated that if successful with the 12 turbines a £600,000 fund will be available for the community INDEX LINK 40 years. Question was asked to the councillor what do the community want. It was stated by our councillor that there is a feasibility studies been created at the current moment and that we should work with the outcome of the studies to see what the local residence of the community would like. Bute Energy are very keen to work with this feasibility studies outcome. It was noted the consultation will be out during the summer.

The previous minutes were read and signed as correct.

8. Re payment of VAT received the sum of £626.40.
9. Cemetery - the gate are back at the cemetery after renovate, a grant was received from the Bodtegir wind farm for the work. £750.00.
10. Two applications from the Brenig wind farm have been successful £717.60 for a new notice board and £4,500.00 to re surface the football pitch at the Gro.
